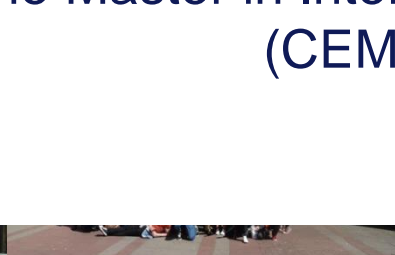

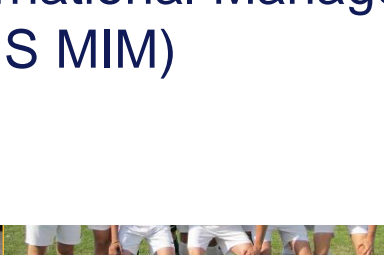

What is CEMS?

- The WiSo Faculty co-founded CEMS in 1988 (together with Bocconi, ESADE and HEC) and is the only German member of the CEMS network.

- together they offer the CEMS Master's in International Management (CEMS MIM).

Admission requirements

Bachelor's degree (finished or at least earned 70% of the required degree CP),

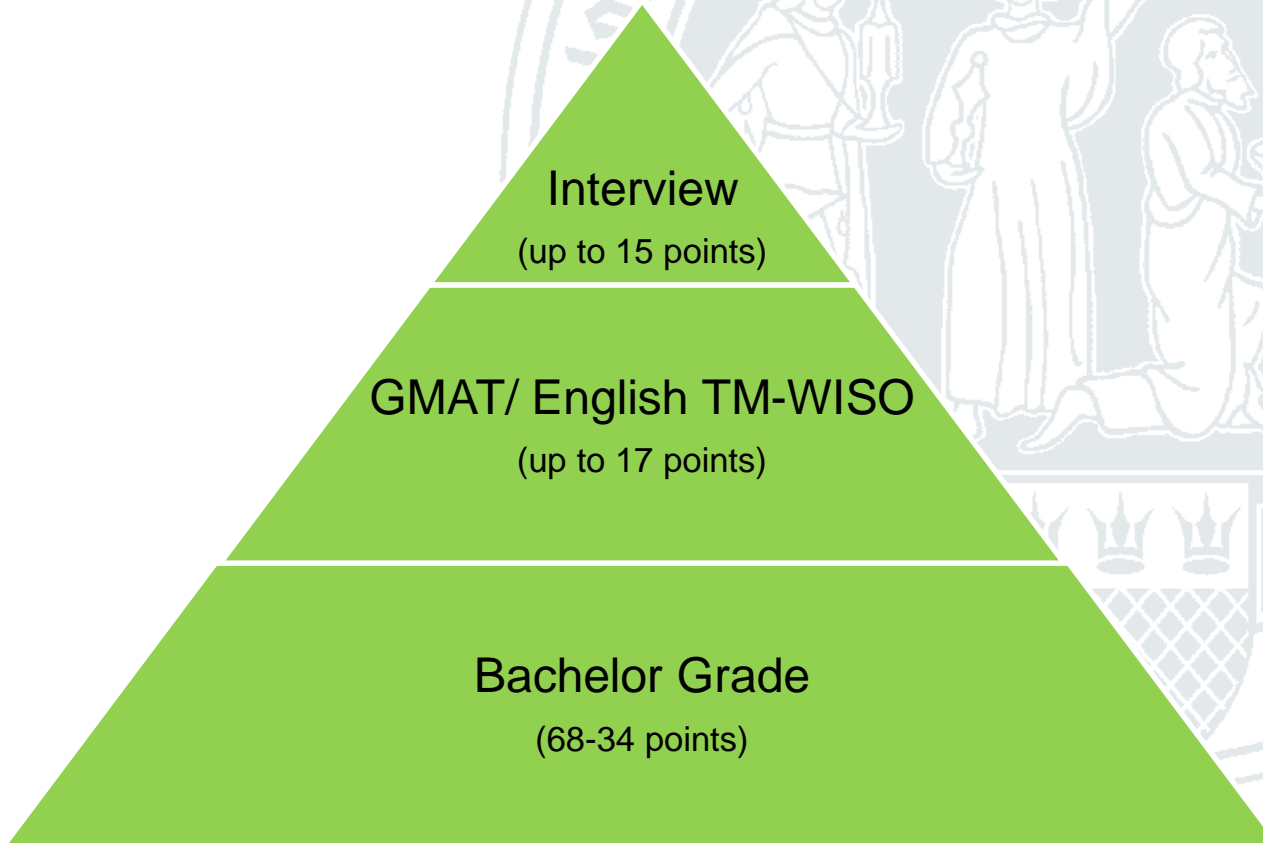
- Overall grade of at least 2.5 (German grade),
- at least 48 CP Business Administration/ Management Studies,
- at least 16 CP Economics,
- at least 10 CP in Statistics/Mathematics

Language requirements

- English level C1: e.g. TOEFL 100 ibt
- 2nd CEMS language (level B2): can be the mother tongue or any other additional CEMS language



Selection Criteria (max. 100 points)





CEMS MIM Admission Process

31st March

- Apply online: cemsmim.wiso.uni-koeln.de
- Applicants with a degree acquired abroad must also apply postal: uni-assist.de/online/uni-koeln

End of
April/ May

- Shortlisted applicants will be invited for an interview.

Mid of
June/ July

- Selected applicants will receive their admission letters.
- Enrollment in Cologne.

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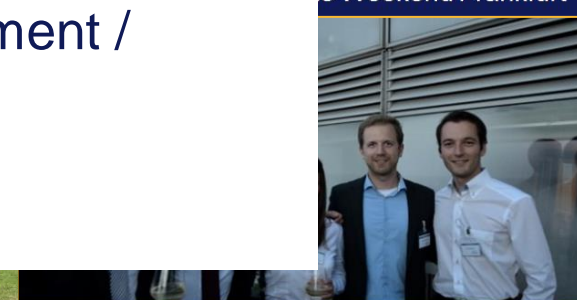
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
